ARKANSAS STATE SENIOR TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Only USBC sanctioned bowlers are eligible.
2. There will be one cash prize awarded for each (8) entries in each Singles Division.
3. Use the highest book average for 2010-2011. New Bowlers may use their current highest league average as of the last night they bowl prior to bowling in the tournament. **The average must be verified by their league secretary.** Bowlers who have no previous average or current average may enter at 210 scratch. All averages must be based on 21 or more games.
4. All bowlers entering the Arkansas State Senior Bowling Tournament must be 55 years of age or older and be a member of a sanctioned USBC Association in the State of Arkansas. Age of bowler at the time they participate in the Tournament will determine division they compete in.
5. Rules 319A-2 (Ten pins higher rule will not apply) Rule 319A-3 shall apply in reporting averages. It shall be each Bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their entering averages It will not be necessary to report previous tournament winnings. Rule 319E does apply.
6. Handicap will be 80 percent of 210 for all divisions.
7. Entry fees must accompany all entries. After an entry has been received, and the dates assigned by tournament management are not refused before preparation of the schedule, the entry fee cannot be refunded.
8. One time participation only. In the event of a tie in any division for first place, the individual with the highest scratch score shall be the State Representative to the National Seniors Tournament.
9. Substitutes shall not be permitted.
- 10. Entries close October 2, 2011.**
11. To be eligible for the USBC National Senior Championship, a contestant must have bowled a minimum of six games at State level prior to participation in the national finals.
12. Singles event shall consist of four divisions based on age groups as follows: A Division (70 Years plus), B Division (65-69 years of age), C Division (60-64 years of Age), D Division (55-59 years of age).
13. No touring professional may compete in this tournament.
14. Entry Fee and Shirt Cost will be paid by AS USBC BA for all divisions singles winners that participate in the National Seniors Tournament.
15. Six games of handicap singles will be bowled the same day on the same pair of lanes.
16. Shirts and blouses must have sleeves and must not contain words or pictures deemed offensive by tournament management. No cutoff jeans or spandex.
17. Prize fund will be returned 100%.

Any rule not covered above, USBC will prevail.
